

Guidelines for Referencing the Feed the Future Innovation Lab for Nutrition

“Feed the Future Innovation Lab for Nutrition” is the full, formal name that should be used the first time a reference is made to the Innovation Lab in all official communications. After the first reference, the name can be shortened to the “Nutrition Innovation Lab”. Subsequent, tertiary references can be shortened to just the “Innovation Lab”. The full, formal name should be used again in any final reference to the Nutrition Innovation Lab. Acronyms, such as NIL or FTF, should not be used in any official communications (e.g., report, slide presentation, poster, or other documentation).

All publications based on data collected or analyzed with funding support of any kind from the Nutrition Innovation Lab, and any individual co-author of a publication whose effort in preparing a manuscript was supported by can be attributed to a level of effort reported for the Nutrition Innovation Lab, must acknowledge such support in the following way:

“Support for this effort was provided by the Feed the Future Innovation Lab for Nutrition which is funded by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID).”

If an output was supported by the Nutrition Innovation Lab jointly with other organization(s), then the correct wording is “Support for this effort was provided jointly by the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (for example) and the Feed the Future Innovation Lab for Nutrition which is funded by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID).”
