JORDAN NUTRITION INNOVATION LAB OVERVIEW

Goal: Support action on optimal infant, young child and maternal nutrition and health in Jordan through rigorous research and capacity building

Objective I: Develop and implement a rigorous research agenda around maternal, infant, and young child nutrition (MIYCN)

Objective II: Support Jordan's MIYCN individual and institutional capacity building through in-country partnerships and collaboration

JNIL RESEARCH METHODS WORKSHOP GOAL

- JNIL in coordination with the JNIL Technical Advisory Committee and Mindset, are pleased to announce the call for application for the third Nutrition Research Designs and Methods Workshop
- The overall goal of the workshop is to **train upcoming Jordanian students, professionals, and young scientists** on the rigor of research methodology and enhance skills in conceptualization, development, implementation, and analysis of robustly designed quantitative and qualitative research protocols.

JNIL RESEARCH METHODS WORKSHOP OBJECTIVES

The specific objectives of the workshop are to:

- Identify the basic concepts of research processes and components.
- Learn to critically read and search the literature in order to identify research gaps in scientific knowledge.
- Gain substantive knowledge in the developmental and structural processes in preparing a research protocol.

JNIL RESEARCH METHODS WORKSHOP OBJECTIVES CONTINUED

- Learn to write a research question that is specific and measurable using quantitative methods.
- Select and develop appropriate research design, sample, data collection, and analysis methods for studies in the area of public health nutrition.
- Develop a Letter of Intent and Research Plan on a specific topic that will be presented in written and oral form.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Potential participants should be **master's students** trained in nutrition and/or **public health nutrition and doctoral students and mid-career professionals** who may be researchers, policy specialists and/or technical officers in governmental and local non-governmental organizations would benefit from exposure to public health nutrition research methodology.

Potential participants should demonstrate a strong interest in working in community/public health nutrition research and practice.

WHO CAN APPLY (CONTINUED)?

Applicants typically are from the following fields:

- Nutrition science
- Nutrition policy
- Public health
- Medicine
- Nursing
- Pharmacy
- Other allied health sciences.

TIMELINE

The workshop has both an online and an in-person component:

- **Online** will be **June 30 – July 25, 2024** with weekly meetings and assignments.
- **In-person** will be **August 3 – 8, 2024** in Aqaba, Jordan.

Students will work in groups of three to prepare a research proposal on an assigned topic and present the final proposal at the end of the workshop

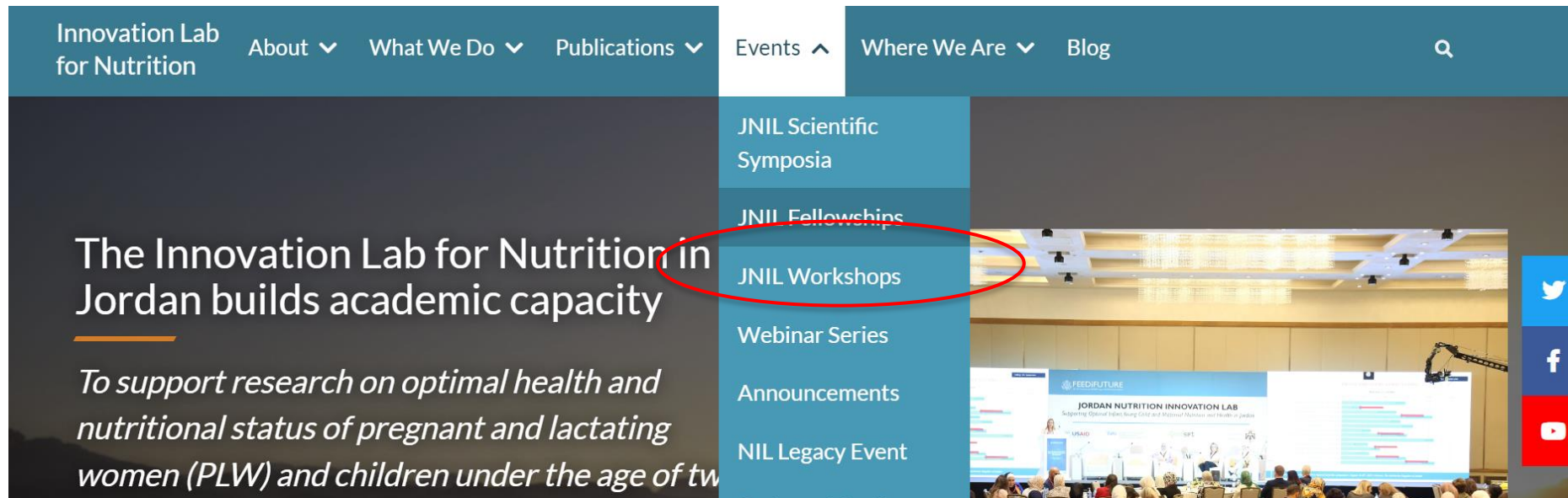


